

DEFORT RC

Recovery of dishes and kitchen utensils

CHARACTERISTICS

DEFORT RC is a fast action energetic descaling powder, chlorinated and alkaline, specially formulated to remove tough stains in cups, crockery and different utensils. Its formula contains active chlorine for the removal of stains and pigmentation, such as tea, coffee, red wine, chlorine etc. Effective also against food stains and shriveled remains of starch.

HOW TO USE

Fill the recipient with cold or warm water adding a dose between 10 and 20 gr of DEFORT RC per litre of water and stir the solution dissolving easily the product. Then immerse the utensils for 30-60 minutes depending on the embedded dirt, washing afterwards manually or automatically. Do not immerse the decorated crockery, plastics and melamine for more than 30 minutes.
